- Profanity and derogatory remarks are prohibited. Your language and attitude should always be respectful.
- Participants should contact their camp counselor with any problems at any time throughout the week.
- Participants are not to leave the premises or the assigned area without permission and/or accompanied by a counselor.
- Participants are **LIABLE** for any **DAMAGE** or **LOSS** caused by his/her actions to university property.
- Participants should leave personal valuables at home.
- All participants must remain each night in the campus residence.
- There will be no changing of rooms by any participants. Boys are not permitted in girls rooms and vice versa.
- Once camp counselors have indicated lights out, all participants must be in their assigned rooms. (Room checks will be done.)
- Participants must comply with the policies and procedures of Acadia University.
